Sixth Report of Session 2017–19

- Create a national oversight committee for investigations of alleged research misconduct
- Problems with clinical trial reporting and transparency



#### Changes to the research integrity Concordat

- Concordat being revised following S&T Cte. report
- UKRIO helping the Signatories
   Group with the revision
- New version: mid 2018?
- UKRIO will:
  - Revise our Self-Assessment Tool
  - Complete work programmes that have been paused while the Concordat was being revised
